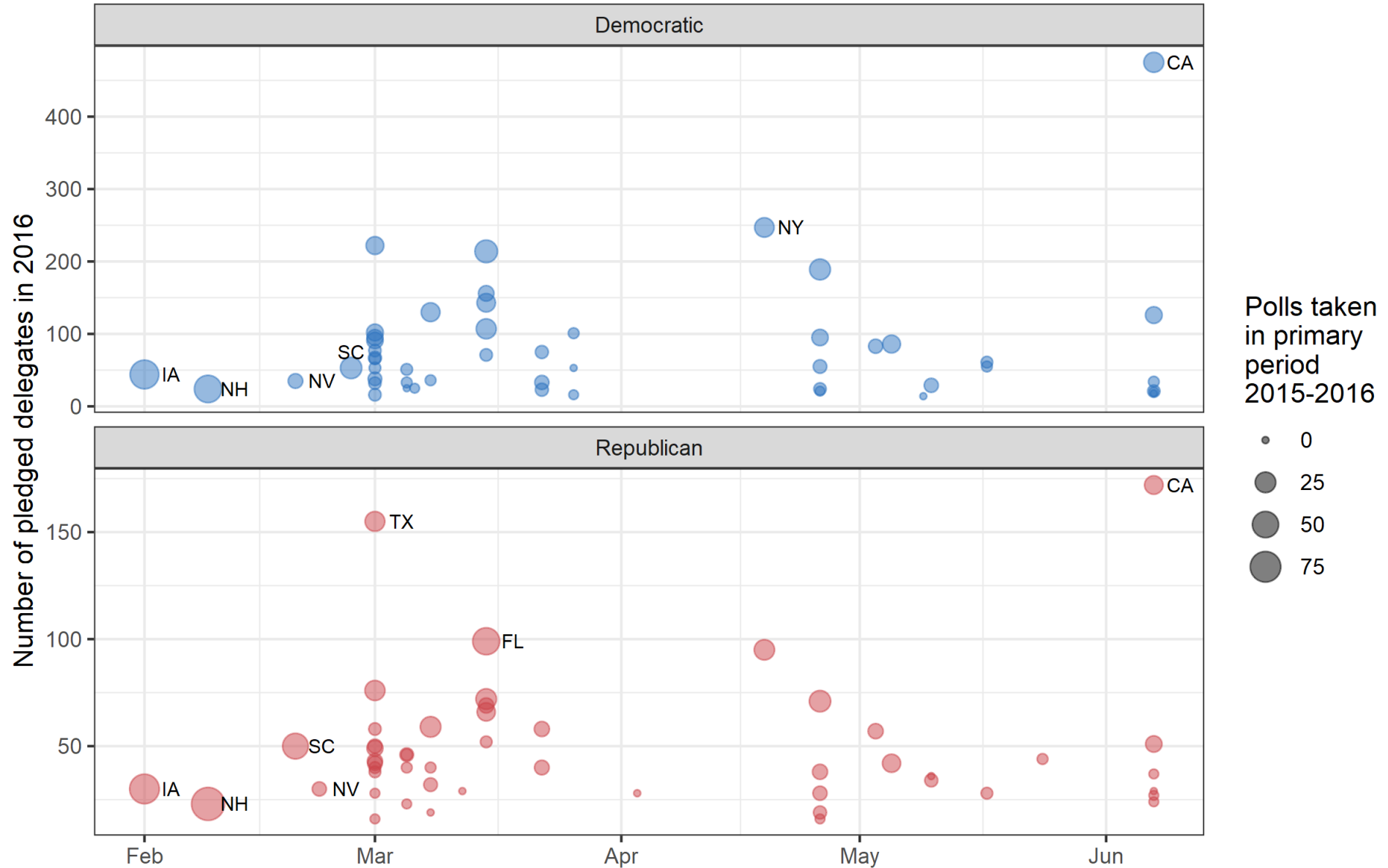


Early Presidential Nomination Contests Get Outsized Attention

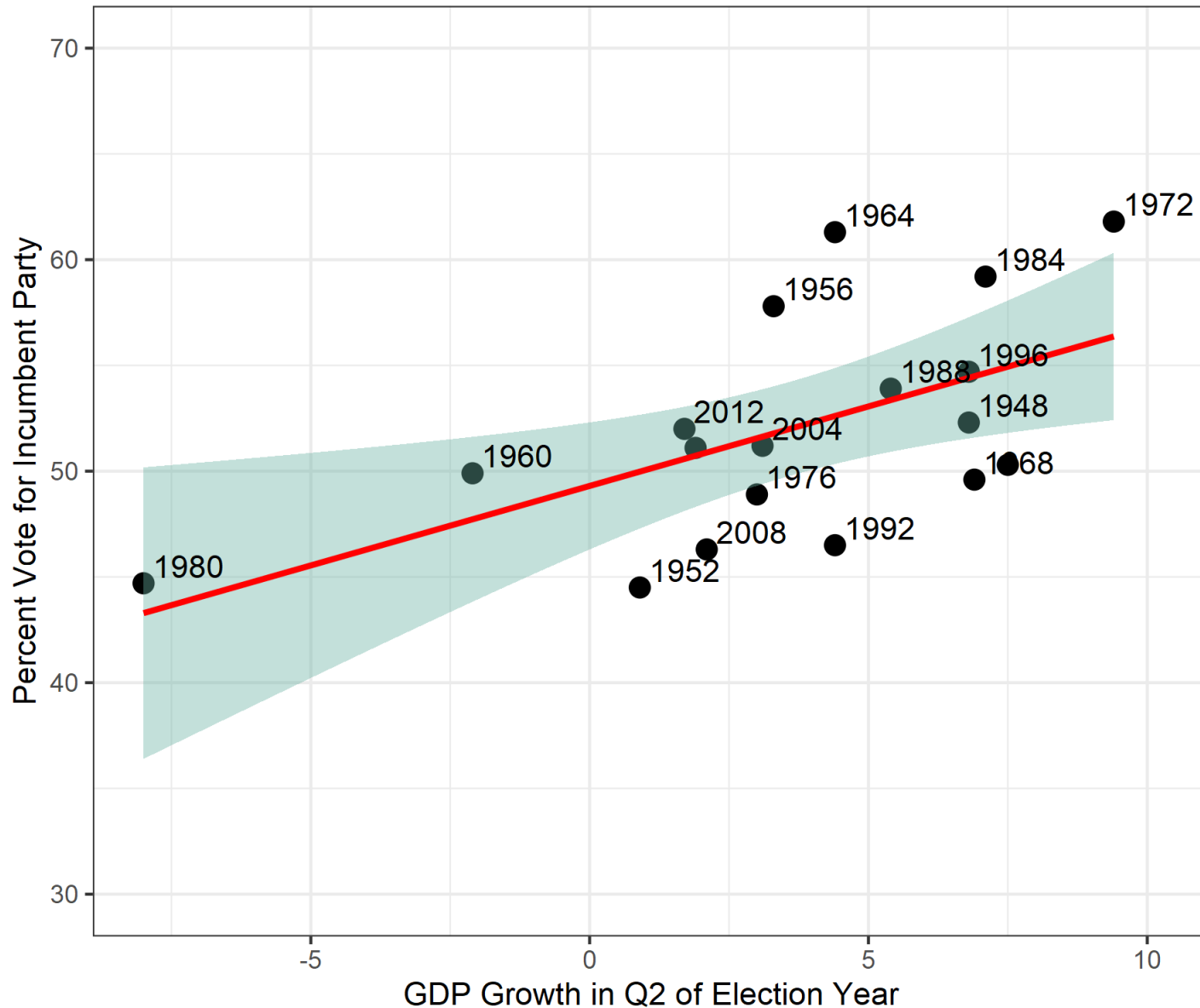
States that vote first are polled more, but select few delegates.

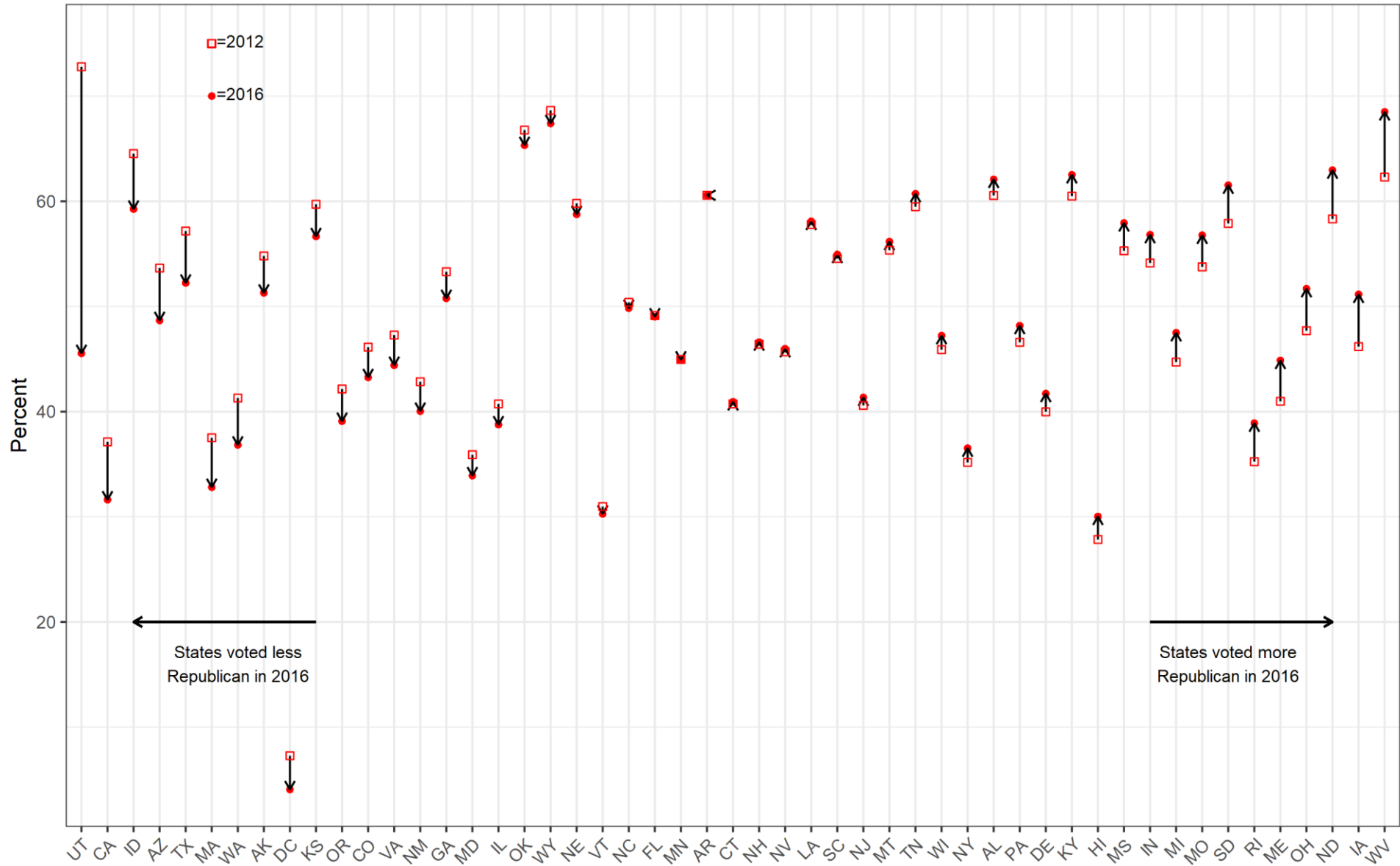
The Economy and Presidential Election Results

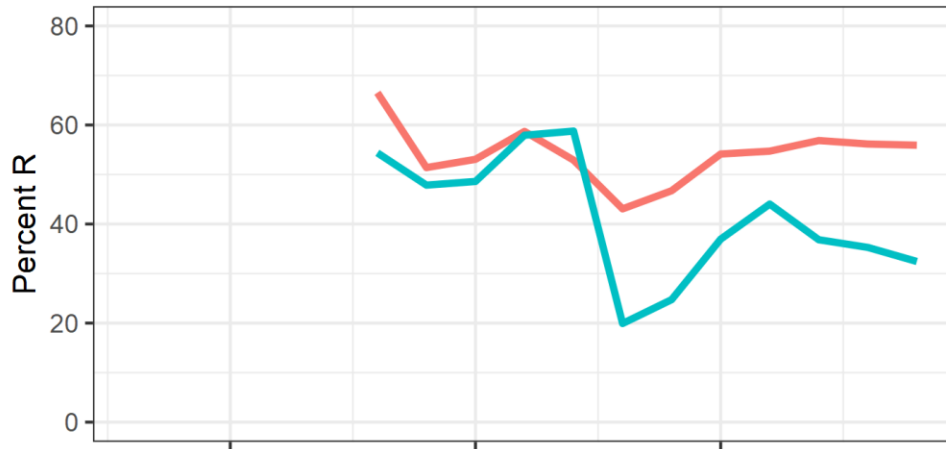
Republican Voting for President among Select Groups, 1952-2016 - A



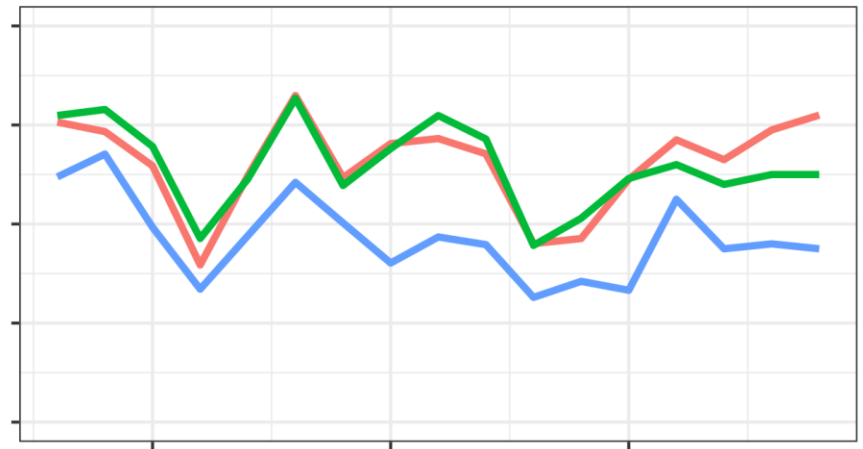

Republican Voting for President among Select Groups, 1952-2016 - B

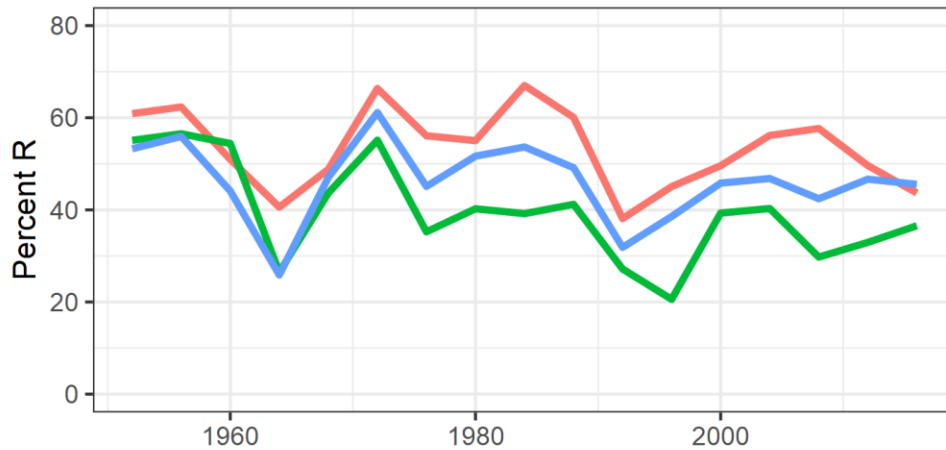

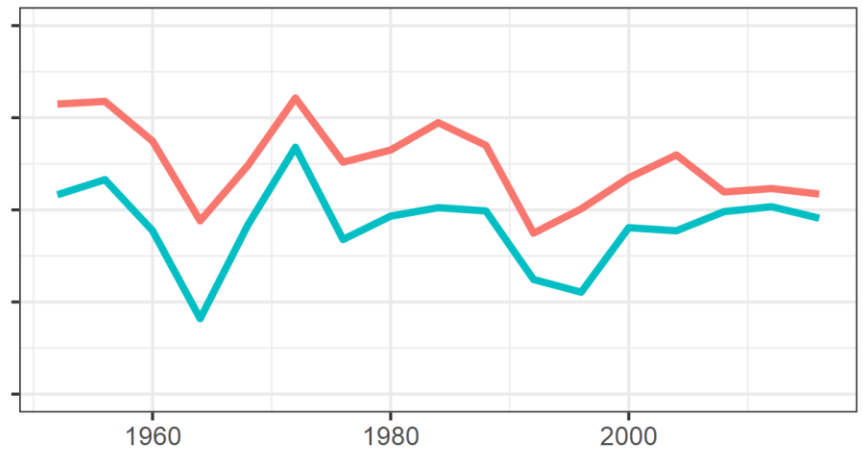
